

Civil Society in Action for Protection of Child Rights in Albania-EU Grants-FAQ

Who is eligible to apply for a grant?

- Civil Society Organizations
- Community Based Groups,
- Youth Groups
- Professional Groups
- Community Based Service Providers

that are active in the field of Child's Rights.

Potential applicants are formalized groups that:

- are registered with a Court Registration Act in Albania
- are registered at the Albanian tax office, NIPT
- are situated and acting in the territory of Albania

What is the timeframe of the program?

- June 6, 2016 – CSAPCRA call for proposals opens
- 10 July 2016 - Deadline for requesting clarifications
- July 21, 2016 (5:00 p.m.) - Grant proposal submission deadline
- July 28, 2016 - Information to applicants on administrative checks and pre-selection
- August 25, 2016 - Information to applicants on the evaluation of the Full Application Form
- September 1, 2016 - Grant agreements made effective

How much is each grant award?

- Small sub-grants (5,000-10,000 EUR)
- Large sub-grants (20,000-30,000 EUR)

Does the grant scheme award multi-year grants?

- The duration for the small grant projects may not be less than 6 months and not exceed 12 months.
- The duration of the large grant projects may not be exceed 18 months.

What are the criteria used for reviewing the grant applications?

The evaluation committee considers many factors when evaluating a proposal. Proposal evaluation is based upon:

- Relevance of proposal to the priority themes made public
- Soundness of the project's conceptual framework

- Quality, clarity, specificity and feasibility of the project proposal.

Will hard copy applications be accepted?

No, hard copy applications only will not be accepted. Applications must be submitted in one original and one copy in A4 size. Besides, the complete application form (full application form), budget and logical framework must also be supplied in electronic format (CD-Rom) and by email at csapcra.albania@savethechildren.org
